DIRECTIONS

HOLLOWAY ROAD TRAILHEAD: From SR 19 in Palatka, drive 12 miles west on SR 100 to Holloway Rd. Turn right. Continue 2.5 miles on dirt road to trailhead turnoff. Turn right. Park on left. Equestrian trailhead with picnic tables and restrooms is 0.2 mile up the same road.

NEAREST SERVICES

Florahome, 4.6 miles southwest along SR 100, has convenience stores and gas.

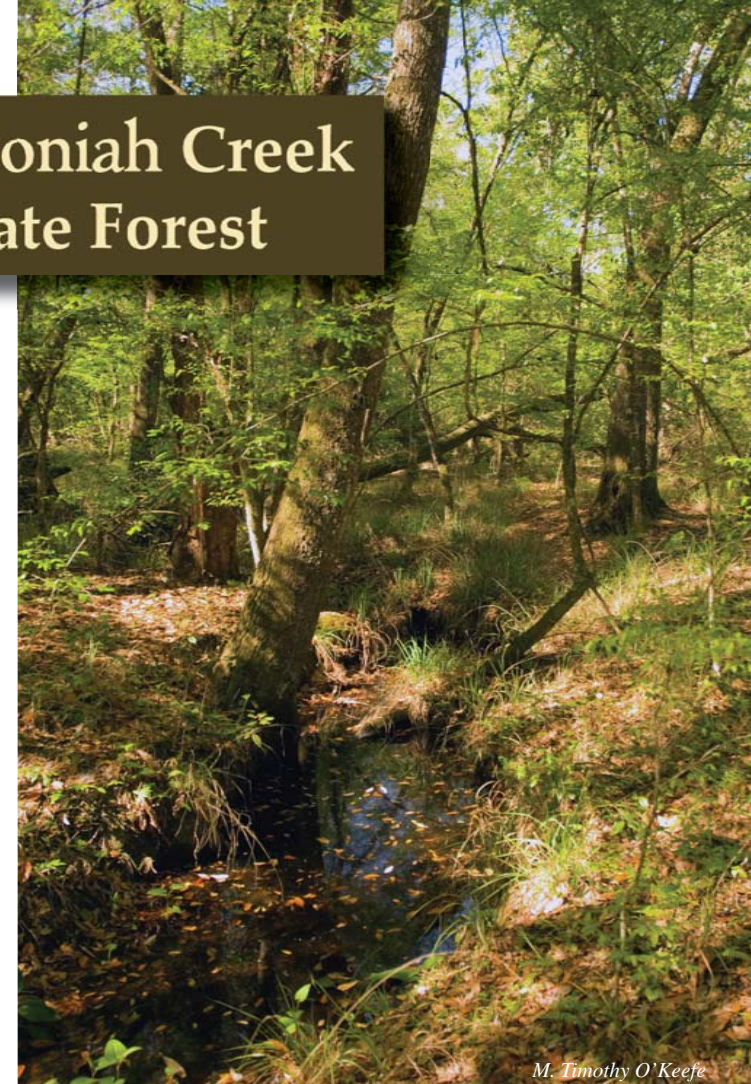
