

FORGOTTEN CREEK LOOP



Forgotten Creek Loop is an adventurous circuit weaving through the Red Doe, Forgotten, and Lafayette trails, with two crossings of Black Creek.



You will traverse a pair of shallow fords over Lafayette and Forgotten Creeks—expect wet boots!



Along the way, you'll trek through a beautiful mix of Longleaf and Slash Pine restoration areas, shady floodplains, and rolling uplands. Be prepared for muddy sections and exposed roots.

Length: 13.3 miles

Duration: 5 - 6 hours

Trail Rating: easy - moderate

Terrain: creeks, tree roots, and water

Trailhead: Lafayette Creek Trailhead



FORGOTTEN CREEK LOOP: 13.3 mi. Lafayette Creek TH to Airport Road via FT & return (FT 7.8 mi + 5.5 mi. via service roads).

Note: Two minor streams to ford on L-6.
