

STEEPHEAD OUT & BACK



Steephead (Out and Back) leads adventurers across several charming footbridges spanning small creeks that weave through lush floodplains and mixed uplands.



Along the way, hikers will discover the dramatic beauty of the Steephead Ravine, pause at the Steephead Campsite, and wander through an open Longleaf Pine restoration area alive with native sights and sounds.



The campsite serves as the perfect turnaround point—a peaceful spot to rest, enjoy lunch, and take in the surrounding natural beauty before beginning the return journey.

Length: 7.4 miles

Duration: 3 - 5 hours

Trail Rating: moderate

Terrain: creeks, tree roots, and possible mud

Trailhead: Owls Head (Hwy 331)
